PLAYER OF THE YEAR

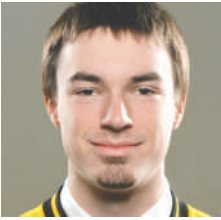
Nicholas Platais

Gonzaga / Sr. Goaltender played in all 27 games throughout the Eagles’ undefeated season, recording 11 shutouts, a 0.94 goals against average and a .954 save percentage. Ended his high school career with a 41-save performance to lead Gonzaga to a second consecutive Mid-Atlantic Prep Hockey League championship game win over Calvert Hall. Platais logged 2,712 minutes in 65 games and made 1,229 saves in his three-year varsity career.

Four-year varsity player led the Raiders to a 12-1 record and a conference championship with a team-high 10 goals and 21 points.



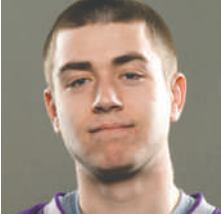
D Austin Schoenfeld
